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1 Description of the questionnaire

According to the criteria setted to correctly measure the level of satisfaction of the learning activities proposed during the December 2-days workshop, the DSU set up a tool. The questionnaire was aimed at evaluating the perceived effectiveness of all the activities.

The questionnaire consists of 15 items, of which 14 on the Likert 5-point scale, and 1 open-ended question; the Likert 5-point scale goes from "very agree" to "not at all agree".

The questionnarie is related to the following areas:

- completeness of content and presentation of the arguments;
- organization and management of the workshop;
- methods of participation and activities of the working group;
- usefulness of new knowledge regarding domestic violence and in particular with respect to perpetrators.

The questionnarie is in Italian language.

2 Results

Two referents for each partner (twelve members) participated to the mutual learning activities and to the workshop. In addition, 10 operators of the OLV service participated voluntarily to the 2 days workshop, bringing their experiences and know-how with respect to domestic violence management services and in particular in the treatment of perpetrators.



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The data obtained by the self-report questionnaire highlighted a overall high satisfaction in relation to the experience conducted; infact the average level of satisfaction of all the workshop experience is 4.5 points out of 5. In particular, in relation to the knowledge and skills acquired, 100% of the participants involved referred they were very much satisfied of their participation to the activities of mutual learning and to the discussion. The participants expressed a high level of satisfaction for the content proposed and they referred the perception of having enriched their professional skills in domestic violence. In particular, the participant referred the importance to implement reflection spaces, such as those proposed in the workshop, to increase among personnel awareness on their own prejudices towards the perpetrators. The participants also rated very satisfactory the participation to the *equality group*. Furthermore, the organization and management of the activities was positive and functional evaluated.
